Let me begin the New Year with a question for you: “How are you doing spiritually?” In case you hadn’t noticed, our motto text for this year is the same as last year! Why? Well I think the answer ought to be fairly obvious. But for those of a slightly slower mindset, the answer is: because we haven’t yet fulfilled this task. We are called to be a witnessing community who are devoted to Christ and in love share Him with those outside of His kingdom. This witnessing is the mark of a healthy church, listen to what Mark Dever a pastor in Washington writes:

“Christians often leave evangelism to the “professionals” out of a sense of inadequacy, apathy, ignorance, fear or simply feeling that it is inappropriate for them to do it. Perhaps they’re not sure of what evangelism entails and how it should be done. And this situation is tragic. I’m convinced that one of the distinguishing marks of a healthy church is a biblical understanding and practice of evangelism”

Evangelism is one of the marks of a healthy church, but equally it is also one of the marks of a healthy spirituality.
