Some excerpts from the **NK:PUSH news letter**;

The Government deals harshly with all opponents, including those who engage in religious practices. Christians have been beaten, arrested, tortured and killed.

It is widespread North Korean perception that Christianity is “a bad element”. At least a quarter of the Christians are imprisoned for their faith in political prison camps, from which people rarely get out alive.

However the Christians are brave and dream of reopening the churches being closed under the Kim reign.
