This morning as we look at Exodus chapter 25, I want to show you how we need to move away from simply being content with the expected to a longing and hungering for a taste of heaven itself.

'A Christian is a called one'

As we hit mid-point in the golden chain of Romans 8: 29 – 30 we will see how the Christian is the one who has been called. This is one of Paul's wonderful ways of thinking about the church, namely those'...loved by God and called to be His saints' Rom 1: 7. To those in Corinth he says 'To those in Corinth ... called to be saints (1 Cor 1: 2) he also uses this understanding to think of the church and himself in these places; Gal 1: 6,15; Eph 1: 18; 4: 1; 4: 4; Col 3: 15; 1 Th 4: 7; 2 Th 2: 14; 1 Tim 6: 12; 2 Tim 1: 9; Jude 1: 1. It is also the way that Peter, John, James and the writer to the Hebrews understands the church/Christian. So the universal teaching of the New Testament makes it clear that the Christian is one called. But do we know what that means? May God give us grace to see and understand .
