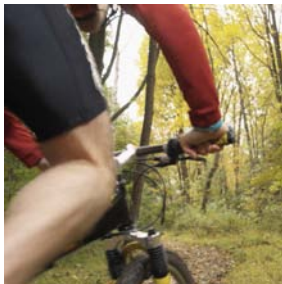


As a Church, we want to bring people to know Jesus, and into membership of His family; to develop, encourage and motivate them to worship God and to serve Him in the Church and the community

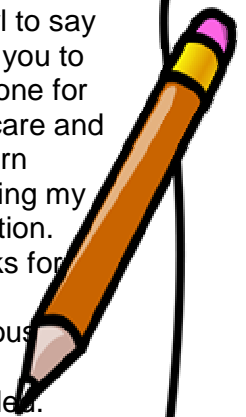
Pray that the Lord would lead us in the direction he would have us go in finding a Co-Worker for BRBC.
