This Morning - Introducing Jesus: Mark 3: 31-35 The love of God and the will of God.

Have you ever sat back and just asked 'What is Gods will for my life?' I've lost count of the amount of times I've come across friends, family and acquaintances struggling with knowing God's will for their lives. Yet Jesus seems to suggest that all His sheep hear His voice and follow Him, being lead by Him. As we come around this portion of Mark's gospel and hear the teaching of Jesus we'll see the link between knowing the love of God and the will of God.

This Evening - Romans 8: 35-39 Nothing can separate us from the love of God in Christ.

As we reach the climax of this teaching on assurance Paul unleashes all the possibilities; tribulation, distress, persecution, famine, nakedness, slaughter, death, demonic forces and powers and more. And shows that over them all stands the steadfast love of God. A love that does not change or alter, a love which when wrapped around an individual cannot be removed. I am sure that it was while reflecting on this portion of Scripture that these words were penned;

*No condemnation now I dread
Jesus and all in Him is mine!
Alive in Him, my living head,
and clothed in righteousness divine,
Bold I approach the eternal throne,
And claim the crown, through Christ my own.*
