Introducing Jesus: The Divine Warrior

Mark 11: 1 -11

This section of Mark would normally be preached the Sunday before Easter. It records the triumphal entry of Christ into Jerusalem. However it is my hope to spend the Easter weekend in Mark's account of Christ's passion, which will then bring our study in Mark's gospel to a close. In this section Jesus is introduced to us, I believe, as the Divine Warrior. There are times when it is great to have someone who can draw alongside to listen, or perhaps to give wisdom, or even perhaps to help carry a burden, but there are equally times when it is great to know that someone else will fight for you. That someone cares enough to enter the fray on your behalf. This morning we'll simply be considering Him.

Romans 16: 1 -16










