"The Glory of God"

Update on WEST children's project in Kenya

You will remember James Martin's appeal, earlier this year, for help from BRBC to support the WEST Special School in Kenya. Donations have been generous and continue to come in.

The aim of the appeal was that we would supply funds to build a school and housing for disabled children. Since the initial appeal, James has spent a lot of time gathering more details about the exact nature of the proposed project and its ongoing sustainability. A pilot group of representatives from across the fellowship have met and monitored the progress over a number of months.

It became clear that, for the project to be set up on a sound and sustainable basis, we would need to appoint a Project Manager on the ground, in Kenya, to oversee the work. It also became clear that the project's future plans are on a much larger scale than was first envisaged.

For these reasons, our practical involvement does not seem feasible at the present time.

Please continue to pray for the school and the invaluable work that it is doing, and also for guidance as to how best to pass over the funds that we hold, to the project.

2. Pray that the latest issue of the "Messenger" dealing with the question "Is there a loving God?" might be used of the Lord to stir people up.

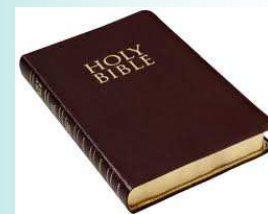
3. Pray that we may continue to be faithful to the Lord and so continue to experience His presence with us when we meet. Pray also for those who are not too well.
