We have the same thinking and the same love, the same as Christ that is. Equally since we are all, Christians that is, saved by the blood of Jesus we are to have full accord, that's a relationship that's very close, our thinking on this based on the cross of Jesus (v2). We are to do nothing from selfishness but recognise everyone else as more important(v3). The final point is a simple one, be more concerned about other people than yourself. But what does that really mean, and what if they don't return the love? And what if I just get treated like the proverbial doormat? And do you only do this if they respond? And how many times should I try this? I hope that all these questions and more may be answered as we look into this verse together.

Ephesians 1

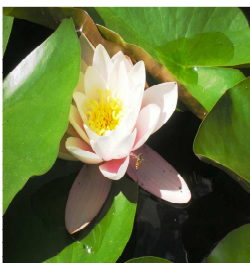
