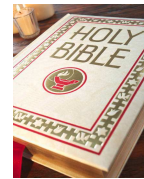
As a Church, we want to bring people to know Jesus, and into membership of His family; to develop, encourage and motivate them to worship God and to serve Him in the Church and the community

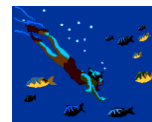

Ephesians 3: 1 - 13



Last week in Ephesians chapter one we saw that our worship springs not from what we want to do, but rather, from understanding who God is and what He has done for us in redemption. He has chosen us, bought us with the blood of his Son, written us into His will, securing a glorious inheritance for us, and given us the Holy Spirit as a guarantee of that inheritance. Seeing all this should cause a heart to respond in worship. One of the words commonly translated as worship in the Bible, actually means 'to serve.' So it should be of no surprise that this section in Ephesians is actually an encouragement that urges those who have seen the redemptive-act of God (His love) to respond in service. Will you plunge in? Have you seen?
