This Morning

Col 1: 14 In Him

Christianity is centred on a person, Jesus Christ. This is hardly surprising when you think that Jesus was, and is, unlike any other religious teacher. All other supposedly great religious teachers pointed people away from themselves and towards God. Jesus however pointed people towards Himself. His call was that people would come to Him. It should hardly be surprising then to find that the New Testament posits the blessings of salvation 'In Him'. This morning we will look a little more at what that means and why union with Him is central to everything in the Christian life.

This chunk of Proverbs presents people pointed in two directions. One that is pleasing to God the other that is not. The great thing about these verses is that they present this image from so many different sides, or views that we really do get a clear picture of the person who is facing in the wrong direction, and of the person facing in the right direction. 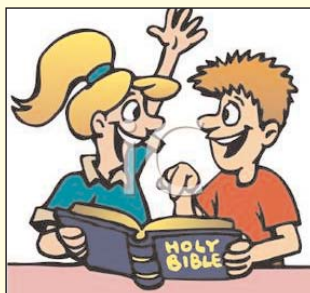
